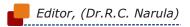
From Editor's Desk :

Live Projects Undertaken By Students :



BUS SCHEDULER

Objective : To automate the manual scheduling of bus resources and generate automated routes with the passenger data provided.

Justification and need of the system : The bus scheduler aims at increasing the cost effectiveness of running buses via all stops that need to be overed. It helps create economical bus routes as per passenger data provided and additional feature is provided for handling special cases when specific students/faculty from specific branches need to be picked up from their respective stops.

Description : The front end is in VB.NET, providing user-friendly forms, taking data from the backend SQL Server.

It authorizes only the administrator to handle the database fro passengers, bus resources, generation of routes and distance between two stops.

The heart of the entire project lies in the routes generation, in cases where the passengers exceed resources, the new routes will not be generated, at each node the number of passengers are checked. In case there are no passengers it makes sense to skip that node and not cover it. The special occasions have also been covered. However, 171 unique cases arise, out of which only 10 most frequent ones have been handled.

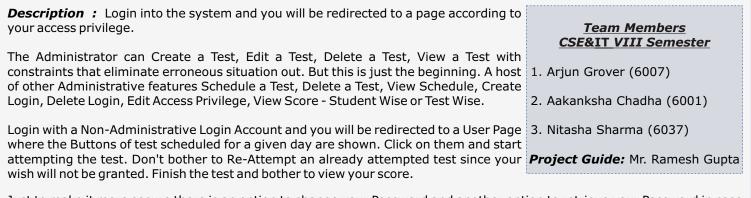


ONLINE SKILL EVALUATION SYSTEM (OLSE)

Student's Viewpoint About The Department :

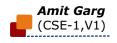
