a) 10+2 Pass with Physics & Maths

b) The current ALTP with 2500 hours of experience, including 1000 hours of multi engine (more than 5700 k.g. weight category) and with 500 hours of command experience on Dornier -228 and current endorsement of IR on the type.

2. Jr. Executive (ATC)

First Class (60%) **Engineering Degree in Electronic/Telecommunication/Radio Engineering** or a recognized University OR Passed Section A and B in first class (60%) of the Exams of the Institution of Engineering (India) in Electronics/Telecommunication/Radio Engg. Subject, OR pass in the Graduate Membership Exams of the Institution of Electronics and Telecommunication Engineering (India) in First class (60%) OR Passed Associate Membership exam parts II and III sections A and B of the Aeronautical Society of India (Electronics) / Avionics as a group) in first class (60%) OR First class (60%) Master's degree in science with physics OR first class (60%) Master's degree in science with Maths as principal subject, with physics as one of the subject during graduation.

SELECTION PROCESS

The selection shall be made on the basis of written test and or interviews.

CONCESSIONS FOR SC/ST (for Sl. No. 2 & 3 only)

- a) Upper age limit is relaxable by five years. (**Only for Sl.No.3**)
- b) No application fee
- c) Candidates **not** working in Government / Autonomous Body / PSU will be paid second-class rail fare for interview only by shortest route as per AAI rules.

CONCESSION FOR OBC (for Sl. No. 2 & 3 only)

Upper age limit is relaxable by three years.

CONCESSION FOR J&K RESIDENTS (for Sl. No. 2 & 3 only)

Upper Age limits is relaxable by five years to all candidates who had originally been domiciled in the State of Jammu & Kashmir during the period from 1/1/80 to 31.12.89.

CONCESSION FOR EX-SERVICEMEN (for Sl. No. 2 & 3 only)

As per Govt. rules i.e. total service + 5 years as age relaxation

The concessions are subject to enclosing attested copy of certificate as proof of belonging to SC/ST/OBC and other categories from a competent authority in the format prescribed by Government of India, for appointment in Govt. Service.

GENERAL:

1. Besides basic pay, DA, CCA, HRA and other benefits such as Medical, LTC, Leave Encashment, Gratuity, PF, etc. admissible as per AAI rules will be paid.
2. In addition to above, Pilots will be entitled to Flying allowance, Commander Allowance, Rating allowance, Qualification allowance, special Travel allowance, Insurance allowance and other allowances subject to conditions as per rules.
3. The selected candidates will be paid a consolidated amount of Rs. 7500/- per month as stipend during the training period and after successful completion of training, they will be placed in the regular pay scale (Not applicable for Pilot).
4. Selected candidates are liable to be posted anywhere in India.
5. Employees of Govt./Public Sector Undertakings should forward their applications through proper channel.
6. The written test will be held at the following centres:- Delhi/Mumbai/Kolkata /Chennai / Guwahati /Allahabad /Ahmedabad / Hyderabad/ Nagpur and Thiruvananthapuram. The No. of centres can be reduced depending upon no. of candidates and in that case, the candidates will be adjusted in the nearest centre.
7. Candidates who do not possess qualification as on 01. 08. 2005 need not apply. Application of candidates who have appeared in the final examination and awaiting the result will not be entertained.
